FORMULATION GUIDELINES

RHEOLOGY

Rheology and viscosity can be ajusted using associative thickeners, such as Coapur™ XS 22 ⁽¹⁾, Coapur™ 3025 ⁽¹⁾, Rheotech™ 2800 ⁽¹⁾ or Rheolate® 278 ⁽²⁾. Cellulosic thickeners are also convenient such as Natrosol® 250 HR ⁽³⁾ or Walocel™ CRT 1000 PV ⁽⁴⁾.

OTHER ADDITIVES

The use of defoamers is recommended, Foamaster® MO 2134 ⁽⁵⁾, FoamStar ED 2522® ⁽⁵⁾, Agitan® 281 ⁽⁶⁾ have proved to be efficient.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

ENCOR® 2100 should be stored indoors in the original, unopened and undamaged container, in a dry place at storage temperatures between 5°C and 30°C. Exposure to direct sunlight should be avoided. The product is protected to prevent any microbial deterioration during normal conditions of storage but care should be taken to avoid accidental contamination during subsequent handling and processing. In the above mentioned storage conditions the shelf life of the resin will be from the shipping date.
