According to the final application, addition of specific defoamers can be required. The adjustment of pH to 7-8 is recommended to ensure a better compatibility with pigments and fillers.

## **STORAGE AND HANDLING**

ENCOR® 5163 should be stored indoors in the original, unopened and undamaged container, in a dry place at storage temperatures between 5°C and 30°C. Exposure to direct sunlight should be avoided. The product is protected to prevent any microbial deterioration during normal conditions of storage but care should be taken to avoid accidental contamination during subsequent handling and processing. In the above mentioned storage conditions the shelf life of the resin will be from the shipping date.
