FORMULATION GUIDELINES

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

SYNOLAC[®] 2126 S 75 is a general purpose resin with a wide field of applications in sealers and topcoats. It is specially recommended for combinations with SYNOLAC[®] 7025 S 50 HV and SYNOLAC[®] 7035 S 55 so as to improve the solids content while keeping a good speed of hardening.

The topcoats based on SYNOLAC® 2126 S 75 are easy to matt and show an excellent scratch resistance.

The reaction ratio is calculated from the respective equivalent weight or hydroxyl and isocyanate content of the reactants. The relationship is:

Hydroxyl Equivalent Weight = (17*100) / %OH

Isocyanate Equivalent Weight = (42*100) / %NCO

SOLUBILITY

SYNOLAC® 2126 S 75 is completely soluble in aromatic hydrocarbons, esters, ketones and glycol ethers.

COMPATIBILITY

SYNOLAC[®] 2126 S 75 is compatible with most of the short oil alkyds, nitrocellulose, rosin-maleic resins, amino resins and aromatic and aliphatic polyisocyanates. It is partially compatible with vinyl resins and incompatible with CAB.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

SYNOLAC[®] 2126 S 75 should be stored indoors in the original, unopened and undamaged container, in a dry place at a temperature not exceeding 30°C. Exposure to direct sunlight should be avoided. In the above mentioned storage conditions the shelf life of the resin will be from the shipping date.
